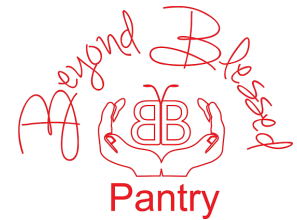


BEYOND BLESSED NEWS

We offer a drive through pantry every Wednesday of the month from 4:00-6:00 PM. We are located at 1515 Walnut Street, Baraboo, just past Pierce Park. There are no residency or income restrictions. Please spread the word about our pantry. Everyone is welcome.

Fun Facts

People generally eat between 3-4 pounds of food per day or roughly 1.2 pounds per meal. An average family of 4 will need between 84-112 pounds of food per week. Beyond Blessed tries to distribute around 85 pounds of food per family per week.

For every \$1 that is donated to Beyond Blessed, we are able to turn that dollar into 7 meals or 8.4 pounds of food!! Isn't that AMAZING!! Your dollar donations go a long way. To donate online, visit our website. www.bbpantry.org
